戰勝 常犯錯

不論在校內試還是公開試中，文法、閱讀、聆聽和寫作都是英文科考查的重要範疇。以下羅列各範疇較典型的常犯錯誤，並提供解題思路，方便家長有效指導子女學習，幫助子女輕鬆戰勝易錯題目，提升應試能力。

文法

常犯錯誤 1 未能正確拼寫序數詞 (ordinal numbers)。

制勝祕訣 記熟特殊拼寫規則的序數詞。

- e.g. 1. My family lives on the twelfth (12) floor.
2. Emma's birthday is on the thirtieth (30) of April.

解題思路

- ① 數字轉為序數詞時，會發生拼寫變化，學生要掌握變化規則。
- ② '12' 的英文是 'twelve'，表達「第十二」時，用序數詞，要將 've' 轉為 'y'，再加 'th'，即 'twelfth'。'30' 的英文是 'thirty'，表達日期時，用序數詞，要將 'y' 轉為 'ie'，再加 'th'，即 'thirtieth'。

常犯錯誤 2 描述過去事件時，混淆不規則動詞 (irregular verbs) 的過去式。

制勝祕訣 把不規則動詞歸類，按變化規則分類記憶。

- e.g. 1. Kelvin read (read) a book last night.
2. Mum knitted (knit) a pair of gloves for Judy two years ago.

解題思路

- ① 不規則動詞轉為過去式時遵循不同的規則，學生要記熟所有規則。
- ② 'Read' 的過去式 and 原形相同，仍為 'read' (但要留意兩者發音不同，過去式的讀音為 /red/)；以一個元音字母加一個輔音字母結尾的動詞，通常要重複末尾的輔音字母，再加 'ed'，'knit' 的過去式為 'knitted'。
